## HABITAT DAY ART CONTEST 2021 RULES AND CRITERIA

By submitting any artwork to the Second Century Habitat Fund for the Habitat Day Art Contest and Exhibition, entrants accept and agree to the official rules and entry requirements. The Second Century Habitat Fund retains the rights to use the art submissions in marketing and promotions. Winners will be selected and featured on Second Century Habitat Fund promotional materials.

### ART CATEGORIES

There are three (3) categories:

- » Drawing
- » Painting
- » Photography

Age Categories:

- » Seniors (65+)
- » Adult (25-64)
- » College (18-24)
- » Teen (13-17)
- » Youth (6-12)

Art entries may be submitted from youth and adults. Each individual may submit only one entry in one of the above categories depicting their vision of South Dakota pheasant habitat or pheasant hunting heritage and traditions.

### ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED STARTING OCTOBER 1, 2020 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2021

Art entries will not be returned as they will be on exhibit at the South Dakota State Fair during the 2021 Habitat Day. However, participants can claim their artwork at the address above or at the GFP/Second Century Habitat Fund booth on the last day of the 2021 South Dakota State Fair.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Please read completely. This checklist is used to determine eligible for entry in the contest:

- » Art should depict a pheasant habitat image or pheasant hunting heritage and traditions in South Dakota.
- » Artwork must be the artist's original work. Entries may not be traced or copied from published works.
- » Artwork cannot be framed.
- » Entries must be postmarked by March 31, 2021.
- » Photographs or images created with computer software are not accepted and will be immediately disqualified. No assistance with computer software is allowed.
- » No names or initials can be visible on the artwork. All names or initials will be covered for judging, which may affect score.

### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- » Concept and Originality: Exhibits creativity
- » Composition: Effective use of form
- » Elements of Art: Color, space, line, and texture
- » Degree of Difficulty: Appropriate for artist's ability and age
- » Wildlife Message Content: Accuracy of wildlife message

### WINNERS:

Each category will have first, second, and third place winners. Winners will have their work posted on the Second Century Habitat Fund website and used on other promotional materials to be determined. Each winner will be recognized at the SD State Fair in 2021.
